

SLOPOA meeting 09/30/03

Discussion took place regarding amending Article IV of the SLOPOA bylaws. The motion was made by Cramer and seconded by Leong to amend the article to require the entire membership to vote on bringing any employees other than the Officers, FST's, Evidence Tech, Records Clerks I & II, and Comm Techs into the POA, and pass by a two-thirds vote of the entire membership. The motion passed unanimously.

Discussion took place regarding donating to the Paso Robles Police Memorial. No motion was brought forth from the membership.

The medical plans and city donations for 2003 and 2004 were presented and discussed. The motion was made by Owen and seconded by Mickel to accept the city's proposal. The motion passed unanimously.
